RECOMMENDATIONS

New Patron for The Trust

The Panel considers that the Executive Committee should invite a suitable individual to become a 'Patron'. The required person should be nationally recognised for their work in related fields; and one who is considered likely to make an outstanding contribution to the broad canvass of The Trust's work. This may be in heritage conservation, education, landscape design, horticulture, architecture, planning and communication. The person should receive an Honorary Membership which would ensure they would be familiar, on a regular basis, with the aims and objectives of the Trust. The appointment of a Vice-Patron could also be considered.
