**HGT Volunteer Student Bursary**

**Terms of Reference**

**Aim:**

- to create opportunities for young people and teachers to develop life-long interests and practical skills in the outdoor environment. They should be between 18 and 25 in age, or, if over 25, within the first 3 years of their horticultural experience.

**Objectives:**

To achieve these aims by:

- encouraging and supporting a person, with their education, training, and early experience in horticulture;
- providing opportunities for the student to learn about and promote the work of The Trust;
- ensuring the student provides a written illustrative résumé of their work, and, an illustrated presentation to be displayed at an AGM, as evidence to HGT members of the outcome of bursary. (Evidence/value of HGT funds).

**The Trust** (Team administering the bursary):

- shall require the bursary recipient to provide a written illustrative résumé of their work, and an illustrated presentation to be displayed at an AGM, as evidence to HGT members of the outcome of bursary;
- shall provide opportunities to raise awareness of the Trust to ensure that students are able to support and promote the work of the Trust;
- shall ensure the bursary recipient provides: a written illustrative résumé of their work; and, an illustrated presentation that is displayed at an AGM; as evidence to HGT members of the outcome of bursary. (Evidence/value of HGT funds)
